Duties & Responsibilities include the following but are not limited to:

- Dismantle affected components for any parts needing examination due to damage or excessive wear
- Use power tools for repairing, replacing, cleaning and lubricating as necessary
- Possible recalibration of systems
- Use hydraulic systems to raise and lower movable parts to check for fluid leaks, ruptured hoses or worn gaskets
- Diagnose electrical problems
- Possible welding with gas or electric welder for broken equipment or structural parts
- Conduct vehicle inspections
- All other duties as assigned
